#### Independence Squares Board Meeting Wednesday, August 31, 2022 Minutes

Start: 7:00PM Eastern (approx.)

Absent: Drew, John, and Coco

**Secretary's Report (report submitted)** – Vinney sent out revised minutes for Board members to review. **MOTION** (by Steve/Ron seconded). Approve the minutes for the July 26, 2022 board meeting? **Yes: 4. No: 0. Abstain: 0** 

Google Drive – Revisit our procedures for using the Independence Squares Google Drive for documents for board meetings and as a repository for board meeting minutes. All waivers and Logos in Google Drive. Anyone who wants access to the links, let Steve and/or Ron know. Our minutes are also listed in Google drive (un-redacted), as well as on our webpage. Steve to upload Will's minutes to Google Drive. Steve to delete the July subfolder for July Board meeting. One member noted that they have 14 years worth of records in Google drive, which we may have if we like, and that storage capacity isn't an issue until one approaches the 15-gig limit.

#### Treasurer's Report (report submitted) - Chris

Treasurer noted \$1,000 Fly-In deposit has not hit our books yet. Ron to investigate payment status. It was noted that the Exton hotel charged us double for a caller's room. With little success to resolve, we will not pursue this further.

How much to charge for the first 8 weeks for members and new students? For prepaid, we will charge \$64 for the first 8 weeks. Alternately, dancers can pay \$5 the first week and then \$10 each week for the remaining 7 weeks. Continue with reduced class fee for financial hardships? Yes, for those who truly need it. President will continue to mention during announcements that dancers who have a financial hardship can speak to us about a reduced fee (currently \$5).

*By-law change:* President is considering asking the general membership to accept a change in by-laws that we no longer require 2 signatories for everything. It was suggested that one possibility is to have the bylaws require signatures on checks dispersing \$500 or more.

*Reduced fee:* members also discussed the finance committee responsibilities, which includes vetting dancers to allow them to pay a reduced entrance fee based on financial hardship.

Need for an Organizational Budget – members discussed whether we need an annual budget, especially since we are a non-profit organization. We are a 501C4, but we are not a registered charity. Ron to check with CPAs he knows if we need an annual budget.

#### Fly-In Report (no report submitted) – Ron and Vinney

*Updates:* there are 94 Registrations to date (down from 1 month ago). Ron created a google group to update folks on new hotel. Ron also reached out to sister clubs to get word out about our Fly-in and the venue change and all 3 agreed to relay this information to their members.

*Decorations:* Vinney and Deb will be meeting to start discussions on decorations for the fly-in. Vinney and Ron to meet with our hotel contact in terms of what we can/cannot do, limitations, and specifications.

Room block rate for 3 nights prior to and after fly-in? Yes, but dancers should reach out to our contact at the hotel to arrange for room block rate if they plan to come before/after the fly-in

Return to Dance Committee (no report submitted) - Ron

It was announced that Linda will continue the COVID tracking that the current RTD chair sends out each week, but we do not have anyone to formally chair RTD. We will continue our discussion about the future of the RTD Committee at the next committee meeting and reevaluate our current safety protocols. Possible discussion items include whether we should require the new bivalent COVID vaccine and what steps to take with the current Monkeypox outbreak. Also, should we do a potluck dinner at the Glitter Ball, with the current COVID trends.

**Glitter Ball Contract and insurance coverage** - Who at the Marion Meeting house do we need to contact to get a contract for the Glitter Ball? It's believed that the meeting house has us penciled in, but no official contract. Steve will reach out to Bob to see if we do have a contract, but he believes we only have a verbal agreement. We need a contract for 2022 ASAP and we should also move forward with obtaining a contract for 2023. Chris will check with our insurance to ensure we are covered for the Glitter Ball events.

**Waiver Storage** – moving forward, Ron agreed to scan the health waivers and store them to Google drive, after which the hard copies will be destroyed.

#### Caller Liaison Report (report submitted) – Linda discussed

Analysis of August 13 Dance – people helped set up/tear down and seemed to have a lot of fun. We even made a small profit. We should consider doing again next year and possibly hire Dayle again.

Potential cohosting opportunities with DC Lambda, Chesapeake Squares and Times Squares next year? Lambda more likely to co-sponsor than Chesapeake, but it wouldn't hurt to ask both. Ron to investigate the Hightstown firehouse as a possible venue for a co-hosted dance with Times Squares.

Staffing our October 8 Dance – Steve, Ron, and Vinney will not be in attendance, so we need to recruit help with setting up and tearing down, collecting the dance fee, checking vaccination cards (if applicable), etc. Chris can help with setting up and collecting fees during the Mainstream and Plus segment and Linda and Dave T will be available during the Advanced and Challenge segment and help with closing down. We will seek to recruit more volunteers at our Tuesday night classes.

*Email reminders* – we had a recent event where a caller forgot there was a dance. Moving forward, caller liaison will reach out to callers as a reminder for special events.

#### Recruitment Committee Report – Steve

*Open house:* 4 New attendees came to the second open house, some from palm cards received and some from Meet-up ads.

Fun Dances: on hold for now.

Demos: John and Coco looking into setting up demos at other clubs.

Ads to other Clubs: send out mock-up of our new class ad for Plus and Challenger dancers (e.g., Perky Promenaders, Busy Bees, Club Sashay, etc.). Linda to ask Mark if he can hand out flyers at his dances.

#### Publicity Chair Report – Ron (written report was submitted.)

A flyer is being created for our "Octoberfest" dance by Roy, which will be posted on our sites. The Publicity Chair will be the keeper of our passwords and login IDs. Chair to organize our website to make it easier to find prior minutes.

#### Mainstream & Plus Report (no written report) Coco and John were not at the meeting

President suggested possibility of using "Lark" and "Robin" terminology in a future mainstream class. Majority of members were not for it. For one, "Boy" and "Girl" are used world-wide, so it could be confusing for new dancers if they go to clubs that use "Boy" and "Girl" if we begin to use "Lark" and "Robin." Some in the group figured we can try it out and see how it flies, then revert to "Boy" and "Girl" if it's not received well.

#### Advanced & Challenge Report – Dave (no written report)

For the foreseeable future, we will continue to wear masks. Dave states that some people are likely to attend future dances because we require masks, while others may not attend because we are wearing masks. He will send out emails to advanced and challenge dancers regarding upcoming dances.

#### **Old & New Business**

Storage Update – Steve spoke to church about renting closet sized space for our supplies and equipment. We will need to discuss logistics of moving stuff out of current storage in Yardley, PA to the church.

Summer 2023 Dances - looks like Steve, Jed, and Drew may co-lead the committee.

No further items to discuss.


